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Is clipchamp trustworthy

I'm extremely frustrated with ClipChamp as I spent 10 hours creating a video that won't download no matter what I do. The process doesn't even start; it just does nothing. I'm fuming! Microsoft seems to be wasting everyone's time, and they don't care about the issue. They know they're getting away with it, so they keep doing it. I used to love using ClipChamp, but now I can't access my work when I reload the website; I get an error message saying something like "locate asset." The only way to backup your media is to upgrade to the paid version. Even iMovie backs up your media for free! It's a waste of time locating all the photos and videos. I like ClipChamp for its ease of use and useful features in the free version. If you just need to cut basic videos and add some text, it's a great option. However, my biggest complaint is the limited customization options. For example, there are few choices for customizing subtitles (although generating them within the tool is great). The transitions are also limited, and there are no animations for text blocks. ClipChamp has become frustratingly slow, constantly buffering every time I try to use it. It's typical of MS to have a program that was decent, then update it and make it worse! I initially had a positive experience using the free version of ClipChamp, making small videos under 1 GB. However, after the app update, my entire work archive became inaccessible, and every time I entered a file, it took forever to load sub-files. It's frustrating that developers consistently make mistakes with updates, especially when it's not broken in the first place. Others have shared similar issues, such as crashing during editing, losing progress, or experiencing laggy performance. Some users even reported receiving copyright strikes on their YouTube videos despite the software claiming music is copyright-free. One user had to re-edit a video from scratch multiple times due to frequent crashes and poor customer service. Another was left feeling frustrated and unsatisfied after experiencing 11 glitches and buffering issues during export. Some users have also expressed concerns about the software's limitations, such as not being able to access project files unless they're still on your PC. Additionally, the loss of uploaded content has been a recurring issue for some users. Clipchamp is also comparable to Adobe Creative Cloud Express, which offers a free version and premium options starting from \$19/year or \$89/mo. In comparison, Clipchamp's pricing starts at \$9/mo for its Creator plan. Clipchamp is surprisingly capable for both personal and professional use, including basic tools, fun effects, and helpful templates for social media posts. However, uncompetitive export speeds and various upsells are notable drawbacks. If the free version satisfies casual filmmaking requirements, there's no need to seek out alternatives. Nevertheless, if more powerful tools and faster rendering performance are needed, CyberLink PowerDirector is a viable option. Clipchamp's latest updates include Image Background Remover, which uses AI to remove backgrounds from still images, and replace them with any desired image. This feature is available on the iOS app, which also features multitrack editing, auto captioning, and text-to-speech capabilities. The Android app is in development. Additionally, Clipchamp has introduced Noise Suppression, Rotate, Silence Remover, and Stock Music, as well as 20 new transitions, including special effects like Bloom, Burn, Glitch, and Pixelate. Premium users can now access their Xbox clips directly within the app. To get started with Clipchamp, simply log in with any email address; however, if you plan to upgrade to Premium, a Microsoft account is required. The app's welcome screen offers templates for starting video projects and displays recent project tiles below. Clipchamp offers various template options, including ads, slideshows, social media posts, and more. On the left-hand side, users have access to other views such as Brand Kit, Template, Settings, and Folders. Notably, Clipchamp's interface remains in light mode until video editing commences, despite system settings. Creating a movie in Clipchamp involves two primary choices: creating a new video or utilizing the automated Create Video With AI process. When opting for the manual approach, users are presented with template options and tools for adding media, music, stock images, text, graphics, and transitions. Media can be imported from local folders, webcams, or online storage services. The app employs a standard three-panel layout featuring a source media section, preview window, and timeline. Users can adjust the relative size of these panels but cannot modify interface element sizes, which may not be ideal for high-DPI screens. The UI design includes touch-friendly features, such as video shortcuts and panel sliding functionality. Basic video editing in Clipchamp is relatively straightforward, allowing users to drag clips from the media panel or click the plus sign to send them to the timeline. Users can also create new tracks by dragging above the top track, with a maximum of 100 supported tracks (though most users will not need more than a dozen). The program automatically detects format changes based on uploaded clips and allows for easy trimming and splitting of track ends using mouse gestures and icons. Clipchamp offers an easy-to-use interface where you can delete unwanted content and use handles to crop, move, or resize clips in the preview window. Right-click options allow for copying, rotating, or flipping clips. Transitions can be added by dragging one of the 49 available options between two clips, with the software automatically handling any overlapping. However, users should not expect the hundreds of creative transitions found in tools like Corel VideoStudio and CyberLink PowerDirector. Clipchamp's Effects section offers over 40 filters that deliver a range of looks, from Disco to Gloomy. These filters can be previewed by hovering over them. The software also features a separate section for effects, which are stronger than filters and add motion and visual effects like blur or zoom. Unlike many alternatives, Clipchamp does not allow grouping content on other tracks so that they move together when another timeline element is moved. Clipchamp's AI-Powered Automatic Movies feature allows users to create videos with four easy steps: Upload Media, Style, Length, and Export. Users can choose from various styles or let the program choose one for them. The software also features a green screen tool, picture-in-picture capabilities, graphics overlays, and Like and Subscribe buttons that cater specifically to YouTube creators. You can start creating your video by selecting the desired style and format. When you tap on a style, you'll see six pre-set music options, which will change later in the editing process. Choose between vertical or horizontal orientation, as well as a time length of less than 30 seconds, one minute, or full-length. Selecting these settings allows you to either export your video immediately or continue to create a new version. The program displays progress while exporting and shows a preview, including some visual effects such as patterns on the side of clips. A 'Keep Editing' button lets you refine your project in the standard timeline editor but disables automatic remixing after that point. Auto-editing also trims parts of clips, so you can unhide sections afterwards. Templates are available for various platforms like YouTube and Instagram Reels, and they include pre-designed elements such as stock footage, background music, social handles, and layouts. They also offer a variety of pre-set titles with animations in different styles. Clipchamp offers various templates for credits, memes, quotes, and ratings, with most resembling advertisement styles, but also includes unique ones like Glitch, Groovy, and Smoke. These templates allow flexibility with over 100 typefaces and font color control. Some styles enable movement and resizing, while others are more stylized. However, titles aren't WYSIWYG and some template text is non-editable. The Auto-Captions tool is a notable feature, allowing one-button auto-captioning with language selection and profanity filtering. Results are impressive, though not perfect, and can be edited. Clipchamp also offers over 380 free background music tracks across various categories, which can be easily added to the timeline. The software allows voiceover recording, automatic caption generation, and volume adjustment. Additionally, it features a Speaker Coach option, providing narration improvement pointers, and an AI text-to-speech tool with over 400 natural voice styles in 170 languages. Other notable features include the ability to mute clip audio, remove background noise, and access various sound effects. Clipchamp is a good choice for social and personal videos as it allows users to export 1080p content without a subscription. However, for more demanding projects or professional use, users need to pay for a subscription. The tool's user experience has improved with the addition of text-to-speech captioning and voiceover tools. It is also suitable for basic video editing tasks such as creating short promotional videos or social media clips. However, Clipchamp lacks some advanced features like transitions, audio filters, keyframe effect editing, and motion tracking. It can take a while to render projects, especially on lower-end devices.
